SAT TEST SCHEDULE

The SAT is offered seven times a year. Most students will take the SATs in 11th or 12th Grade. We recommend taking the SATs twice as more than half of all students take the SAT again — typically in the spring of 11th Grade and in the fall of 12th Grade. Most students will improve their score the second time around. For SAT Subject Tests, most students will take them toward the end of 11th Grade or at the beginning of 12th Grade.
